


Internal Review and Recommendations

The Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) published notice of draft Authorization to discharge under the National Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) discharge for municipal separate storm sewer system (MS4) discharges for Unity Township in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* on March 15, 2025 [55 Pa.B. 2101] (Attachment A). A 30-day comment period was provided during which interested parties were directed to submit comments to DEP.

THE PENNSYLVANIA CLEAN STREAMS LAW AND THE FEDERAL CLEAN WATER ACT

APPLICATIONS FOR NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMITS AND WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT (WQM) PERMITS UNDER THE CLEAN STREAMS LAW AND FEDERAL CLEAN WATER ACT

This notice provides information about persons who have applied to the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) for a new, renewed, or amended NPDES or WQM permit, or a permit waiver for certain stormwater discharges, or have submitted a Notice of Intent (NOI) for coverage under a General Permit. The applications and NOIs concern, but are not limited to, effluent discharges from sewage treatment facilities and industrial facilities to surface waters or groundwater; stormwater discharges associated with industrial activity (industrial stormwater), construction activity (construction stormwater), and municipal separate storm sewer systems (MS4s); the application of pesticides; the operation of Concentrated Animal Feeding Operations (CAFOs); and the construction of sewage, industrial waste, and manure storage, collection and treatment facilities. This notice is provided in accordance with 25 Pa. Code Chapters 91 and 92a and 40 CFR Part 122, implementing The Clean Streams Law (35 P.S. §§ 691.1—691.1001) and the Federal Clean Water Act (33 U.S.C.A. §§ 1251—1376). Section III identifies individual NPDES permit applications received and draft permits indicating DEP's tentative determination relating to stormwater discharges associated with construction activities. A 30-day public comment period applies to these applications and draft permits. The period for comment may be extended at the discretion of the Department for one additional 15-day period. The application is for a renewal of an individual NPDES permit for the discharge of stormwater from a regulated municipal separate storm sewer system (MS4) to waters of the Commonwealth in Unity Township, **Westmoreland County**. The receiving stream(s), Sawmill Run (WWF), Indian Camp Run (HQ-CWF), Ninemile Run (WWF), Fourmile Run (WWF), Loyalhanna Creek (WWF), Sewickley Creek (HQ-CWF), Crabtree Creek (WWF), Slate Creek (WWF), Monastary Run (WWF), and Township Line Run (WWF), is located in State Water Plan watershed 18-C and 19-D and is classified for Warm Water Fishes and High Quality Waters-Cold Water Fishes, aquatic life, water supply and recreation. The applicant is classified as a small MS4.

The EPA waiver is in effect for small MS4s, and is not in effect for large MS4s.
